**WRSFV Taulbut House – Mission, BC**

The Women's Resource Society of the Fraser Valley is looking for a special woman to act as "House Mom" in our Taulbut House project. This person must be gentle and compassionate. She must like young women and children. She must have an understanding of addictions and mental health issues that she may have obtained through years of experience or through a combination of training and experience. This person must also have a sense of humour and an optimistic outlook on life. She must be willing to see the best in people. She must also be a single woman since no partners are permitted to live in the house.

Taulbut House, located in Mission, is a home for high risk young moms or moms-to-be. There are usually 4 – 5 women in the house along with 2 – 4 children. The House Mom is required to facilitate a home-like environment in the house as well as ensure the safety of the residents and the building but is not involved in direct services to residents beyond what would be expected in a shared living space. Programs and direct services are provided by WRSFV Staff.

This position would suit a woman who has an income source but who would benefit from living in a situation that offers a small, three room suite as well as a \$400/month honorarium. The House Facilitator is not required to be present during the day so this position could also work for someone who has a day job. A criminal record check will be required.
